

Dear Parents and Carers

I want to provide information for parents and carers ahead of the Christmas holiday. Please can I particularly draw everyone's attention to the section on positive cases after Friday 18 December.

End of Term Arrangements

Term will end for all students on Friday at 2pm. The school buses will be ready to collect the students at this time. The last day of term is a non-school uniform day. We are encouraging the whole school community to wear a Christmas Jumper and we ask students to bring a voluntary donation of £1 to raise money for the charity Young Minds.

Positive Cases after Friday 18 December

The Government has assumed that schools will continue to operate Track and Trace beyond the end of term, up to and including Christmas Eve. I hope like me, you will accept that this puts additional strain on our staff so I ask you to please read the information below carefully:

- 1. Where a student tests positive for COVID-19 having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school should not be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.
- 2. For the first 6 days after Friday (up to and including Christmas Eve), if a student tests positive for COVID-19, having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, or if asymptomatic having been tested within 48 hours of being in school, please email covidpositive@alderbrook.solihull.sch.uk. Please provide the student's name and year group, as well as the best phone number to contact you on, and a member of the leadership team will be in touch to ascertain if we need to trace contacts at school. We would really appreciate if school can be notified immediately if you are informed of a positive test result.
- 3. Please do not email the above email address after Thursday 24 December.

School will reopen on Monday 4 January.



Solihull Council Winter Support Scheme

In response to the challenges the pandemic is causing for many families, Solihull Council is extending its support to families over the Christmas and New Year period.

This is intended to provide additional help and support to households with food, utility bills and other essentials up to the end of March 2021.

Call Solihull Connect on 0121 704 8100, for information and advice on how to access local community support, food or financial assistance. Solihull Connect can also refer and connect families to local food networks, as well as to the Council's Discretionary Crisis Fund (DCF). The DCF can provide financial and fuel assistance to any household experiencing severe financial hardship. This includes access to food, fuel top-ups and, if needed, essential white goods.
