

School Buses

Please note that the school buses will run from Wednesday 7th September. On Wednesday, they will only pick up Year 7 students for an 8.30am start; all other year groups in school on Wednesday should please make their own way into school at the designated time. The buses will drop off all students as normal on Wednesday afternoon and pick up all students from Thursday morning.

Building work on the school site

Work on the new 7-classroom and reception block has started over the summer holiday. This is obviously very exciting for the future of the school, but it does mean that, in the short term, there will be limited vehicular access to the school site. Please can we ask that you only drive onto site if absolutely necessary, as parking spaces are very limited.

Only disabled visitors and parents/carers with a parking pass will be able to drive onto the school site at the start and end of the school day. Please note that parents/carers of ARC students should continue to use Cartwright playground to pick up students at the end of the school day; members of the Senior Leadership Team will be at the school gates at the start and end of the day to direct new ARC parents/carers onto site.

We will be speaking to all students in assemblies on the first day of term about changes to procedures and movement around the school site due to the ongoing building work.

Open Evening, Wednesday 21st September – early closure

Please note that school will finish at 2pm on Wednesday 21st September to enable staff to set up for the Open Evening. Buses will pick up early on this day. Reminders will be sent out closer to the time. As Open Evening is such an important and busy event in our school calendar, we strongly encourage all pupils to return to school to help on the evening itself.
