

## **Outcome of recent Ofsted Inspection**

Following the ungraded inspection on 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> April, we have now received our Ofsted report which you can view <u>here.</u>

I am delighted to share with you that Alderbrook has remained a 'Good' school.

During the inspection, inspectors spent time observing lessons, reviewing students' work, speaking with staff, students and trustees, and assessing our overall provision. We are pleased that our continuing focus on a broad and inclusive curriculum has been recognised, as has our unerring focus on our students' personal development and mental health. The suggested areas for future focus are fair and achievable, and already areas of work in progress.

We are extremely proud of our students for their conduct and behaviour throughout the Ofsted visit and you will see in the report that the Inspection team, who spoke to many students throughout their time with us, have noted that the students feel safe and happy at Alderbrook and that behaviour in lessons and around school is considered to be good.
