Free School Meals – Frequently Asked Questions

We have had a number of queries from parents/carers and students and thought it would be helpful to include answers to the most commonly asked questions. Please direct any other related enquiry to 2010ffice@alderbrook.solihull.sch.uk

- Free school meals daily allowance to be used at lunchtime only
- Purchases made in excess of this amount at lunchtime must be funded by parents/carers by adding money to their child's ParentPay account
- Purchases made before school or at break time must be funded by parents/carers by adding money to their child's ParentPay account
- Unspent lunchtime allowance cannot be carried over to the next day



- If you feel you may be eligible for free school meals, please apply by visiting: www.solihull.gov.uk/fsm
- ParentPay only shows the money that parents/carers have paid into their child's account, and the
 purchases that have been paid for with that money, which will be anything over and above the
 daily FSM allowance. Any purchases made using the daily FSM allowance do not, therefore, show
 on ParentPay.
