A Trustee must be aged 18 or over at the time of their election or appointment and cannot be a registered pupil at the school. A person cannot hold more than one governorship at the same school.

A person is disqualified from holding or from continuing to hold office as a Trustee if he or she:

- becomes incapable by reason of mental disorder, illness or injury of managing or administering his or her own affairs;
- fails to attend the Trust Board meetings without the consent of the Trust Board for a continuous period of six months, beginning with the date of the first meeting missed;
- would be disqualified from acting as a charity trustee by virtue of section 72 of the Charities Act 1993 (or any statutory re-enactment or modification of that provision).
- has had his or her estate sequestrated and that sequestration has not been discharged, annulled or reduced
- is the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order or an interim order.
- is or becomes included in the list of teachers and workers with children or young persons whose employment is prohibited or restricted under section 1 of the Protection of Children Act 1999
- is or becomes disqualified from working with children under section 28, 29, 29A and 29B of the Criminal Justice and Court Services Act 2000
- is a person in respect of whom a direction has been made under section 142 of the Education Act 2002.
- has, at any time, been convicted of any criminal offence, excluding any that have been spent
 under the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 as amended, but excluding any offence for
 which the maximum sentence is a fine or a lesser sentence except where a person has been
 convicted of any offence which falls under section 72 of the Charities Act 1993.
- has not complied with the Trust's DBS policies. Trustees are required to be familiar with the DBS policies and must act in compliance with them.

Where a person becomes disqualified from holding or continuing to hold office as a Trustee and he or she is, or is proposed, to become such a Trustee, he or she shall upon becoming so disqualified give written notice of that fact to the Governance Professional.

I confirm that I am not disqualified from serving because of the criteria listed above.

I confirm that in the event that I am elected/appointed I will notify the Governance Professional to the Trust Board immediately should I become disqualified during my term of office.
