Language skills are in demand! So whether your students are interested in teaching, translating, interpreting, tourism or business, the opportunities for linguists are endless.

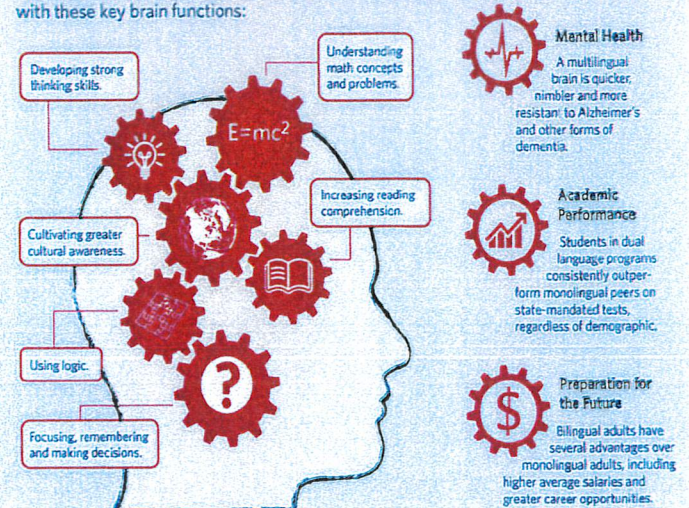
